FAQs

What is included in the fees?

School fees include lunch and snack as well as all resources and trips.

How and when will I be invoiced?

Fees are charged on a termly basis and due on or before the first day of term.

Can I pay the fees monthly?

The School does not offer an option to pay monthly directly to the School however, School Fee Plan offer a similar service.

Do you accept taxfree childcare?

Yes. School fees can be paid using taxfree childcare until the end of term in which your child turns five. After this point, taxfree childcare can only be used to pay for wraparound care.

How does the government funding for 3 and 4 year olds work?

The School will be able to claim funding and deduct this from the invoice for eligible children (from the term after your child turns three until the end of term your child turns five) as long as you complete a form at the beginning of each term.

^{**} After school clubs run from 15:30-16:30. Externally run Clubs will be charged at a greater amount than advertised here; the cost will be disclosed at the time of booking. All children staying after school receive a cold snack. Children staying beyond 16:30 receive a hot tea (served at 17:00). FAOS

What is included in the fees?

The morning session includes breakfast and lunch and the afternoon session includes tea, both provided by our onsite caterers. Snacks and educational resources are also included.

Will the fees change as my child gets older?

The fee levels in Little School remain the same regardless of the child's age. It is only the minimum session requirements that change.

How and when will I be invoiced?

Little School invoices will be sent monthly via email. The system we use for invoicing annualises (sometimes referred to as stretched) bills. This calculates a flat monthly fee for your child's time in Little School, based on a yearly average. It means that the invoices will be the same each month (aside from the month your child joins, leaves or changes their pattern) and avoids costly fluctuations in fees.

How does the government funding work?

The School accepts 15 and 30 hour funding for eligible children. To check your eligibility, visit

Can I book ad-hoc sessions in addition?

Yes, subject to availability. Ad-hoc sessions are charged at 20% higher rate.

Can my child attend a mixture of morning and afternoon sessions?

Yes, your child can attend a combination of morning and afternoon sessions.

How do I register?
