

UNIFORM LIST ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025 RECEPTION



At Greenfield we have a winter and summer uniform schedule, as per below.

AUTUMN TERM : S P R I N G : SUMMER TERM

SEP OCT NOV DEC JAN FEB MAR APR MAY JUN JUL

Your choice

You can wear either your summer or winter uniform from Sept to Oct half term, and from April to May half term.

Winter

Winter uniform is compulsory from October half term through to the end of the Spring Term.

Summer

Summer uniform is compulsory from after the May half term through to the end of the school year.

On days when children have PE or swimming, they come into school wearing their PE kit.

On days when children are in uniform, they must wear either the blazer *or* winter coat into school (but do not need to wear both).

All items are compulsory unless otherwise indicated. *Items indicated with an asterisk must be purchased from Stevensons.

WINTER UNIFORM

OPTION A

- Blazer*
- Polo shirt
Plain white. Branded polo shirt available from second hand uniform while stocks last.
- Grey trousers or Bermuda shorts
Trousers must be dark grey dress style. No 'cargo-style' pockets, flares, stretchy fabric or embellishments. Please click to view [preferred style A](#) or [preferred style B](#).
Children may wear shorts year-round if they wish.
- Sweatshirt, pullover or cardigan*
- Grey ankle socks
- Cap* (optional)
Optional and available only from second hand uniform while stocks last.



OPTION B

- Blazer*
- Pinafore tunic*
- Polo shirt
Plain white. Branded polo shirt available from second hand uniform while stocks last.
- Pullover or cardigan*
- Green socks or tights
Bottle green, plain. No bows, embroidery or patterns.
- Winter hat* (optional)
Optional and available only from Stevensons upon request, or second hand uniform while stocks last.

SUMMER UNIFORM

AS WITH WINTER UNIFORM BUT WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCHANGES:

OPTION A

Shorts (instead of trousers)

Shorts should be dark grey, dress style with no cargo-style pockets. Children may choose to wear shorts year-round if they so wish.

Hooped day socks*

With shorts only. If preferred, children can wear dark grey ankle socks with shorts.

Children may opt to wear a white shirt and Greenfield tie, which is compulsory from Year 1 upwards.

OPTION B

Summer dress* (instead of shirt and pinafore)

White knee length or ankle socks

Plain. No bows, embroidery or patterns.

White leggings (optional)

These can be worn by those who wish for further covering during the summer. These can be short style, mid-length or full-length but should be plain white only. Please see modesty section below for further information.

Summer boater* (instead of winter hat. Optional)

Optional and available only from Stevensons upon request or second hand uniform while stocks last.



PE KIT

- Green shorts*
Children are permitted to wear plain black leggings under their PE shorts if desired. Please see modesty section below for further information.
- Polo shirt
Plain white. Children should wear the polo top they have as part of their normal uniform. It can be either branded or not.
- White ankle socks
- Green jogging bottoms
Must be same shade of bottle green as the sweatshirt, if not sourced from Stevensons.
- Sweatshirt*



FOOTWEAR

- Black school shoes
Must not be patent.
- Predominantly white trainers
For use in the Sports Hall. Please purchase velcro if your child cannot tie their own laces.

FOREST SCHOOL

- Puddle suit
No specified colour or design but must be long-sleeved and long trouser length.
- Under-clothes
For example, leggings and a long-sleeved top.
- Wellies and socks
Any design but must be clearly labelled.



ALL CHILDREN MUST ALSO OWN

Winter coat*

Legionnaire sun hat*

Rucksack*

Water bottle

Any design but must be clearly labelled.

Blue lightweight rucksack* (optional)

Whilst this item is not required in Reception, if transitioning from Little School, please do not throw away your little backpack as this will be used in Year 1 upwards.

Lunch overall*

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Woolly hat and scarf*

Other designs are not permitted.

Gloves

Plain green or black only.

HAIR STYLES AND ACCESSORIES

Fringes should not cover a child's eyes. Closely shaven hair and fashion hairstyles are not permitted. Where a child's hair falls below the collar, it should be tied back using a scrunchie or headband available from Stevensons or plain dark/bottle green hair accessories.

MODESTY

We want all of our pupils to feel comfortable in their uniform and be able to participate fully in school life.

For those choosing to wear Option B of the summer uniform (summer dress), children are permitted to wear white leggings of any length under their dress. For Option B of the winter uniform (pinafore or skirt), children are permitted to wear bottle green tights. For PE kit, children have the option to wear black leggings under their shorts if desired during the summer.

Any additional garments which children wear in line with their cultural or religious beliefs (e.g. head covering) should be either black, bottle green or white - reflective of the winter/summer uniform being worn.

LABELLING UNIFORM

All uniform must be labelled with the child's first initial(s) and surname.

Shirts, tops, sweatshirts etc. should be labelled in the back of the neck

Trousers, shorts, jogging bottoms etc. should be labelled in the back of the waistband

Shoes should be labelled on the inside sole using a 'sharpie' or marker pen.

Bags, accessories, equipment and all other items should be labelled in a clear and obvious place to aid staff when lost items are handed in.

Labelling items with a mark or symbol is not acceptable as it does not enable staff to identify the owner.

Items that are handed in to the school office without an obvious name label are placed in the lost property basket for one term. After one term, unclaimed items are donated to the second hand uniform or a suitable charity.
